Senior Signing Day 2026

As we prepare for a memorable Senior Signing Day 2026, we want to ensure all families, students and guests know that the safety of our attendees is our highest priority. We are dedicated to maintaining a secure and supportive atmosphere for all. We are excited to celebrate the incredible achievements and bright futures of the Class of 2026, together with valued members of our DSST community! **To create a secure and welcoming environment, DSST is implementing enhanced safety and security measures for this year's event.**

These include:

- **On-Site Security Presence:** With up to 10,000 attendees at SSD, dedicated security is essential. We will have three uniformed, off-duty Denver Police Department officers wearing lanyards on-site to ensure safety and respond as needed. DSST designated staff personnel wearing lanyards will also be stationed at entry/exit doors throughout the day until all students are safely on their buses returning to schools.
- **Law Enforcement Protocol:**
In alignment with [DPS Administrative Policy J1H](#), uninvited law enforcement and federal immigration officers are not permitted at DSST/DPS schools, on district property, at school events, or on transportation to and from those events. Senior Signing Day is a DSST school event, and these protections apply. Any uninvited law enforcement or Immigration & Customs Enforcement personnel must present a valid, signed judicial warrant before entering.

We will take all available steps to ensure these safeguards extend throughout the event and related transportation.
